* These offices are on the ballot to fill a vacancy. The two candidates with the highest number of votes in the primary will be nominated to the general election unless one candidate receives a majority of votes in the primary election. If one candidate receives a majority of the votes cast in the primary election, that candidate alone is nominated to the general election. The candidate that receives the highest number of votes at the general election will be elected to the office.

However, if only one or two candidates file for these offices to fill a vacancy, then those candidates shall be the nominees for the office and be forwarded to the general election. ORS 249.091.

** **County Judge** (who exercises judicial functions) currently must file candidate filings with the Secretary of State. Changes were made by the 2001 Legislative Session to the definitions in ORS Chapter 249, resulted in this office being classified as nonpartisan, but also resulted, albeit inadvertently, in this office being included as a "state office." Upon consultation with the Attorney General's office, it is determined that candidate filings, voters' pamphlet filings and any recall petition filings for the office of County Judge must be made with the Secretary of State. A fix to this situation will be included in proposed legislation to the 2007 Legislative Session. County judge candidates must continue to file contribution and expenditure reports with the appropriate county elections official.
