



# **ORESTAR Version 2.1.1 Release Notes (8/23/2007)** for External Users

The following release notes relate to the Campaign Finance portion of ORESTAR and are broken out according to the navigation tabs on the campaign finance pages.

## **Transactions**

### Bug Fixes

#### → File When Due

Previously, transactions that were filed using the file when due feature were erroneously receiving the message "Transaction may be considered late." This message displayed because the transaction due date was set to 4:00pm, the time when the system would begin processing filed when due transactions each day, and the filed date was set to 5:00pm. Now, both the due and filed dates are set to 5:00pm and the erroneous late message will not display. Filed when due transactions will still begin processing at 4:00pm each day.

## **Upload XML**

### Bug Fixes

#### → Validation Message for Invalid Committee ID Number

Previously, when a transaction was uploaded via an XML file and it contained a political committee contact with an ID number that does not exist in ORESTAR, the following error message displayed: "Valid Contact ID does not exist in system or in current file." Now, the error message more appropriately reads "Committee ID provided does not match a committee registered with the State."

#### → Transactions with Association Information

Previously, transactions uploaded via an XML file did not upload successfully if the transaction contained an association to a transaction that was not yet filed (e.g. account payable/cash expenditure were being uploaded in the same XML file). Now, these transactions will successfully upload.

## **Documents**

### Bug Fixes

#### → Transaction Filing Reports

Previously, there were situations where transactions filed at the same time were split into multiple transaction filing reports. There were also random cases of transactions not appearing on a transaction filing report. Now, all transactions filed in one batch should appear on a single transaction filing report.
